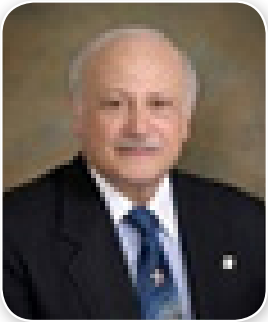

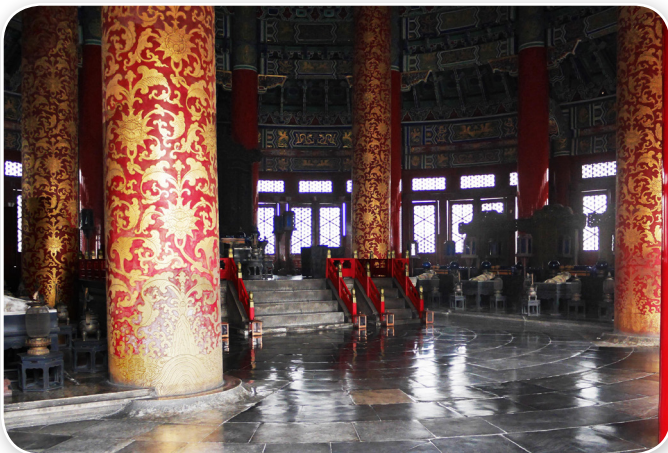

# About Beijing

*Beijing, Jing for short, is a city in northern China and the capital of China. Lying 70 mi (102 km) west of Bohai Sea, it outskirts Hebei Province toward the north, west, south, and for a little segment in the east and Tianjin toward the southeast. This city is a noteworthy transportation center point, with many railroads, streets and motorways going through the city. It is likewise the goal of numerous universal flights landing in China. It is viewed as the political, instructive, and social focus of China. With a past filled with over 3,000 years, it has been a basic piece of China's history. There is barely a noteworthy building that doesn't have at any rate some national chronicled essentialness. Being the capital of China for around 850 years, it is one of the Four Great Ancient Capitals of China, offering China's most awesome cluster of attractions. No other city in the country draws in more explorers. As the platitude goes, one who neglects to achieve the Great Wall is not a genuine legend. Without going by the Great Wall, no excursion to this city or the nation is finished. The Great Wall of China is a progression of stone and earthen strongholds in northern China, constructed, modified and kept up between the fifth century BC and the sixteenth century to shield the northern fringes from Xiongnu assaults amid different progressive administrations. At the heart of this city is the Forbidden City, home to the heads of the Ming and Qing administrations, the biggest royal residence complex of the country and the world. The Forbidden City likewise has the Palace Museum with majestic accumulations of Chinese craftsmanship. Siheyuan (Courtyard houses) and hutong (back roads) just develop in appeal as they diminishing in size.*
