






Beijing Attractions

















About Beijing

Beijing, Jing for short, is a city in northern China and the capital of China. Lying 70 mi (102 km) west of Bohai Sea, it outskirts Hebei Province toward the north, west, south, and for a little segment in the east and Tianjin toward the southeast. This city is a noteworthy transportation center point, with many railroads, streets and motorways going through the city. It is likewise the goal of numerous universal flights landing in China. It is viewed as the political, instructive, and social focus of China. With a past filled with over 3,000 years, it has been a basic piece of China's history.
