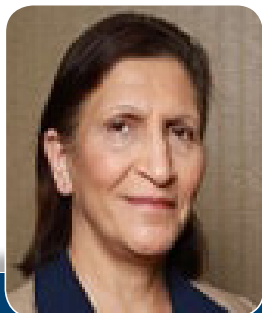
Why to Attend?
