Glimpses of Previous Conferences



About London

London is the capital and most populous city of England and the United Kingdom. [Standing on the River Thames in the south east of the island of Great Britain, London has been a major settlement for two millennia. It was founded by the Romans, who named it Londinium. London has a diverse range of people and cultures, and more than 300 languages are spoken in the region. London's urban area is the second most populous in the EU, after Paris, with 9,787,426 inhabitants at the 2011 census, It is among the oldest of the world's great cities—its history spanning nearly two millennia—and one of the most cosmopolitan. By far Britain's largest metropolis, it is also the country's economic, transportation, and cultural centre. By the 11th century, London was beyond all comparison the largest town in England. Westminster Abbey, rebuilt in the Romanesque style by King Edward the Confessor, was one of the grandest churches in Europe. Winchester had previously been the capital of Anglo-Saxon England, but from this time on, London became the main forum for foreign traders and the base for defence in time of war. In the view of Frank Stenton "It had the resources, and it was rapidly developing the dignity and the political self-consciousness appropriate to a national capital
