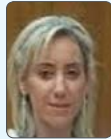

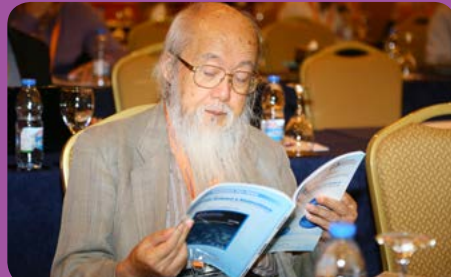

About Berlin

Berlin is the capital and the largest city of Germany, as well as one of its 16 constituent states. Berlin is the second most populous city proper in the European Union behind London and the seventh most populous urban area in the European Union. It is a world city of culture, politics, media and science. Berlin serves as a continental hub for air and rail traffic and has a highly complex public transportation network and it is the greenest city of Germany. About more than one-third area of the city is covered by forests, gardens and parks. The metropolis is a popular tourist destination.
