





BRUSSELS, BELGIUM



Brussels is the capital city of Belgium which is located in the central portion of the country. It covers around 62 sq mi and the population of this city is around 2 million. As the headquarters to the European Union and NATO, this metropolis is often referred to as The Capital of Europe. It is the ultimate European city with a mosaic of languages and cultures paving a way for a vibrant restaurant and nightlife scene. Apart from its famous chocolates and beers, there are almost 90 museums, beautiful parks, architecture, bars and much more. Impossible to miss is the Grand Place, which was built as a merchants' market in the 13th century and has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1938. Smack in the city centre, it plays host to numerous festivals and concerts year round and is also where you can discover the tiny Manneken-Pis, the somewhat peculiar symbol of the city. Towering over surrounding buildings, it can serve as a compass during your exploration of the city. Reopened in 2006, the Atomium, Brussels' Eiffel Tower, provides great views, inside and out. Its European district is a kaleidoscope of cultural activities. From the Parlamentarium, which explains in detail the workings of the EU, and the iguanodons of the Natural Sciences Museum to the vintage cars of Autoworld, there is something to keep everyone busy. It always offers a cosmopolitan atmosphere with cultures from the past and present, and from here and elsewhere. Brussels experiences an oceanic climate with approximately 200 days of rainfall per year. In the summer, maximum temperatures rarely reach 30°C. After October, temperatures can drop off quite rapidly and winter months are often damp and chilly(15°C).
