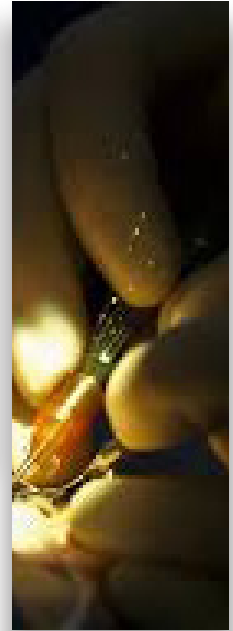

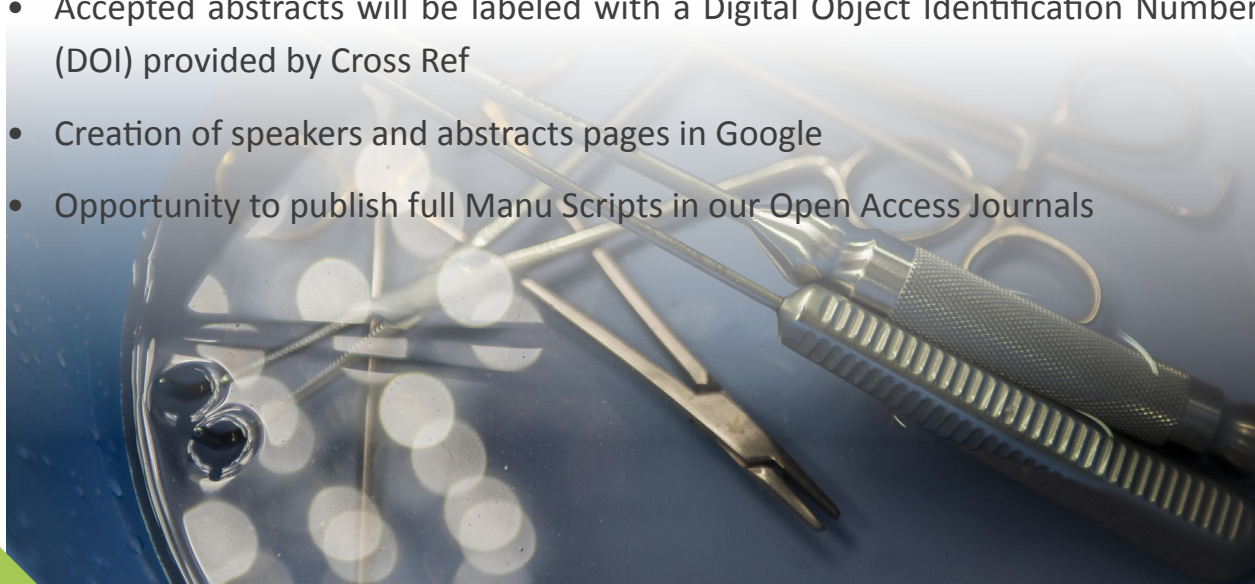

A general surgery have an ideal knowledge on surgical techniques that principally concentrates on wide area such as lungs, heart, liver, pancreas, gallbladder and stomach. General surgery is expected that the certified surgeon with additional intelligence and experience relevant to the pathology, physiology, anatomy, immunology, epidemiology and also in clinical care domains include wound healing, transfusion and disorders of coagulation, infection and antibiotic usage, metabolism and nutrition; minimally invasive and endoscopic intervention (including colonoscopy and upper endoscopy), shock and resuscitation, metabolism and nutrition.

The general surgery market is forecast to grow steadily moving into the next decade. The market was valued at \$14.6 bn in 2017 and is expected to reach a value of \$21.6 bn in 2024, increasing at a Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) of 5.7%, according to Global Data, a leading data and analytics company.

In 2017, the market for endoscopy devices was estimated to be \$7.6 bn and is expected to grow at a CAGR of 7.3% to reach a value of \$12.5 bn in 2024.

An increasing demand for minimally invasive therapies, and advancements in imaging technology is fuelling the growth of the endoscopes market which currently accounts for more than half of the general surgery market in terms of market size.

An increasing emphasis on early diagnosis of diseases such as cancer, is fuelling the growth of the biopsy devices market. This is expected to grow at a CAGR of 2.2% from 2017 to 2024. Increasing obesity rates are expected to drive the market for bariatric surgery devices at a CAGR of 9.3% from 2017 to 2024 due to an increasing number of bariatric surgical procedures.

The robotic surgical systems market is expected to witness significant growth over the forecast period, with a CAGR of 13.5% from 2017 to 2024 for robotic surgical systems used within general surgery.

The general surgery market saw a price erosion in many countries, and the trend is expected to continue throughout the forecast period. Budget constraints on healthcare systems, along with a purchasing process that is becoming more transparent and stakeholder-intensive – is expected to control the costs and effectiveness of the purchasing process; as well as the devices that come with it.

LONDON is the capital and most populous city of England and the United Kingdom., London is a 21st-century city with history stretching back to Roman times. At its centre stand the imposing Houses of Parliament, the iconic 'Big Ben' clock tower and Westminster Abbey, site of British monarch coronations.

Standing on the River Thames in the south east of the island of Great Britain, London has been a major settlement for two millennia. London is often regarded as a world cultural capital. It is the world's largest financial centre.

London is a leading global city in the arts, commerce, education, entertainment, fashion, finance, healthcare, media, professional services, research and development, tourism and transportation. London has a diverse range of people and cultures, and more than 300 languages are spoken in the region.

London's buildings are too diverse to be characterized by any particular architectural style, partly because of their varying ages. Many grand houses and public buildings, such as the Natural gallery, are constructed from Portland Stone. Some areas of the city, particularly those just west of the centre, are characterized by white stucco or whitewashed buildings.

The London Natural History Society suggest that London is "one of the World's Greenest Cities" with more than 40 percent green space or open water. They indicate that 2000 species of flowering plant have been found growing there and that the tidal Thames supports 120 species of fish. They also state that over 60 species of bird nest in Central London and that their members have recorded 47 species of butterfly, 1173 moths and more than 270 kinds of spider around London. London's wetland areas support nationally important populations of many water birds. London has 38 Sites special scientific Interest (SSSI's), two National Nature Reserves and 76 Local Nature Reserves.

London is a diverse and exciting city with some of the world's best sights, attractions and activities. London is home to some of the best museums and galleries in the world. The capital is home to beautiful Royal Parks, including Hyde Park and Richmond Park. The Thames provides a stunning backdrop to many of the city's top tourist attractions. River bus services and river tours are great ways to beat the traffic and enjoy wonderful views. London's famous skyline continues to evolve. There are plenty of places to view the iconic skyline along the river such as View from The Shard or the London Eye. The London Eye observation wheel provides panoramic views of the South Bank cultural complex, and the entire city.

London Climate:

London, the capital and largest city in England and the United Kingdom has a temperate oceanic climate, with warm summers and cool winters. While the city annually has modest precipitation, there are long periods of overcast skies and frequent light mist-type precipitation, which may account for the rainy image of the city.

London - City of DREAMS:

London is a dream city for anyone with a romantic streak or an interest in history. Sightseeing opportunities are to be found in abundance. It's one of the most sought after destinations for tourists and travellers all over the world. All throughout London, every street and every lane is constructed thoughtfully to reflect on its years of tradition. There are so many lavish places of interests for people of all ages to visit in London.

Transport within London:

Train: London has an extensive and developed transport network which includes both private and public services. Public transport services are dominated by the executive agency for transport in London: Transport for London (TfL). TfL controls the majority of public transport, including the Underground, Buses, Tramlink, the Docklands Light Railway, London River Services and the London Overground. Transport for London operates three different railway systems across London.

The largest is the London Underground, a rapid transit system operating on sub-surface lines and in deep-level "tube" lines. TfL also operates the Docklands Light Railway (DLR), an automated light rail system in the east of the city, and the Tramlink system.

The London Underground and the DLR account for 40 percent of the journeys between Inner London and Outer London, making them the most highly used systems in all of London. These three systems extend to most points of London.

Bus: The London Bus network is extensive, with over 6,800 scheduled services every weekday carrying about six million passengers on over 700 different routes making it one of the most extensive bus systems in the world and by far the largest in Europe. Catering mainly for local journeys, it carries more passengers than the Underground. In addition to this extensive daytime system, a 100-route night bus service is also operated, providing a 24-hour service. East London Transit is a partially segregated Bus Rapid Transit system.

Cycling: Over one million Londoners own bicycles but as of 2008 only around 2 per cent of all journeys in London are made by bike: this compares poorly to other major European cities such as Berlin (5 per cent), Munich (12 per cent), and Amsterdam (55 per cent)[39] and Copenhagen (36 per cent).[40] Nevertheless, this is an 83 per cent increase compared to that in 2000.[41] There are currently an estimated 480,000 cycle journeys each day in the capital.

The Santander Cycles (formerly Barclays Cycle Hire) scheme, launched 30 July 2010, aims to provide 6,000 bicycles for rental. Bikes are available at a number of docking stations in central London.

National and International air connections:

London is the best served city by airports in the world with almost 150 million passengers using its six airports in 2005. In order of size, these airports are Heathrow, Gatwick, Stansted, Luton, London City; and London Southend Airport.

Heathrow and Gatwick serve long-haul, European and domestic flights, Southend is used mostly for European flights, Stansted and Luton handle low-cost European and domestic services, whilst London City caters for business passengers to short-haul and domestic destinations.

The closest airport to the city centre is London City in the Docklands area, approximately 10 km east of the City of London financial district. A branch of the Docklands Light Railway links the airport to the City in under 25 minutes.

Two other airports are at the edge of the city but within the Greater London boundary: Biggin Hill, around 23 km southeast of the centre, and London's principal airport, Heathrow, 20–25 km from central London.
