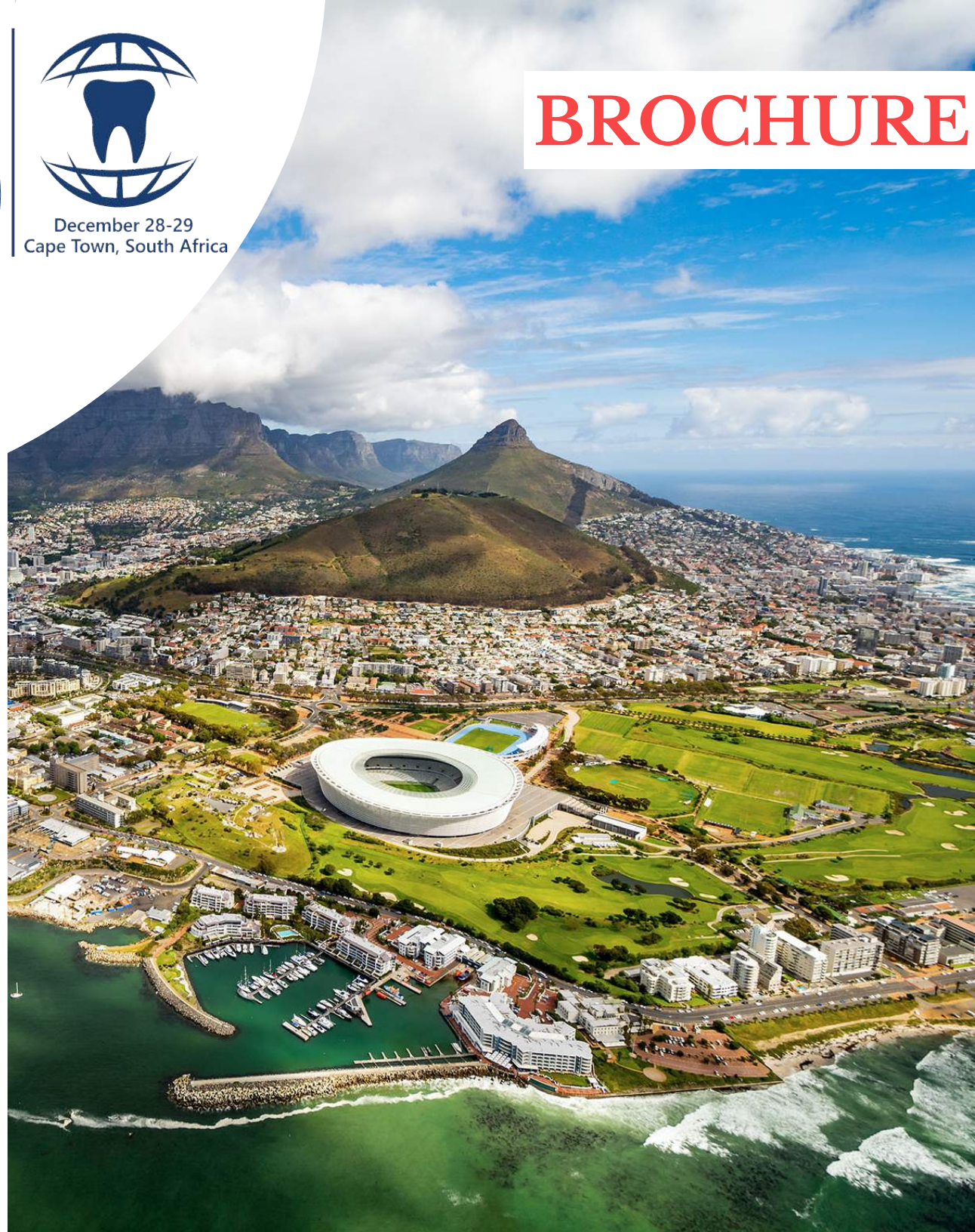

WHY CAPE TOWN?

You really can't overstate the case for visiting Cape Town. First, there's the in-your-face beauty of a craggy mountain range that drops precipitously into a glittering sea, its flanks carpeted in greens and delicate florals. Then there's the pristine white beaches lapped by – it must be said – a chilly Atlantic, their curves defined by giant granite boulders to bake on. Yet, of course, Cape Town is not just about exploring nature because the city has a cool urban edge too. It has always been home to some of Africa's most innovative artists and designers and it is now home to the Museum of Contemporary Art Africa, too.



TOP ATTRACTIONS CAPE TOWN



The **V&A Waterfront** is South Africa's most-visited destination, and it attracts roughly 24 million visitors a year. There are five shopping districts where you'll find everything from local designs to international brands, but there's more to this destination than shopping. There are many coffee shops, restaurants, and bars, most with spectacular harbour views. There's also the new Canal District, with its gorgeous city, harbour and mountain views. Here, you'll find a range of water activities, from stand-up paddling to kayaking and swimming.



One of the New Seven Wonders of the World, **Table Mountain** is Cape Town's centre-piece. If you are relatively fit and are feeling energetic, there are some amazing hikes to try. For those pressed for time, the Aerial Cableway offers a quick and convenient ascent. Cable cars depart from the cable station every 10 to 15 minutes and the journey up the mountain takes about five minutes. The cars rotate through 360 degrees during the trip, affording you spectacular views of the mountain below.



Robben Island is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and has come to symbolise the oppression of the Apartheid government. It was here that Nelson Mandela, alongside many other political prisoners, spent 18 years of his 27 years in prison. However, the island's history predates the Apartheid regime. Over the centuries, it has acted as a prison, a military base, and a leper colony.



Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden is Situated on the slopes of Table Mountain, a mere 13km from the city centre, Kirstenbosch is regarded as one of the great botanical gardens of the world. The 528-hectare estate contains over 7,000 species of plants from southern Africa. Spend the day picnicking on the lawns, strolling through the Protea garden, or discovering interesting plant species in the Botanical Society Conservatory.

TOP ATTRACTIONS CAPE TOWN



The Cape Point Nature Reserve is all about natural splendour. You will be treated to some pretty spectacular views of the Atlantic and False Bay coastlines. While you are there, be sure to spend some time in the nature reserve where you are likely to encounter baboons, Cape Mountain Zebras, buck, and at least some of the 250 species of bird that call this reserve home. If you're lucky, the endless blue of the ocean may just be interrupted by breaching whales or frolicking dolphins.



Boulders Beach near Simon's Town has a lot going for it: the ancient granite boulders protect it from the wind and large waves, making it an ideal swimming spot. The beach is always clean and safe, because it falls under the Table Mountain National Park Marine Protected Area. But the soft white sand and warm(ish) waters are not the only reasons why 60,000 visitors a year make their way along the coast, past Simon's Town, to Boulders Beach.



The Bo-Kaap is a beautiful, colorful neighborhood near the city centre. Its origins as the Cape Malay quarter date back to the late 1700s when houses were built for slaves to be close to the city. It's one of the few neighbourhoods that successfully resisted forced removals during the apartheid era, and has retained a lot of its original character. These days it is one of Cape Town's most picturesque attractions, with bright, pastel-coloured houses and cobble streets.



The Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet with great triumph at the southern tip of Africa, and where better place to celebrate the diverse marine life in these two vast habitats than where it all comes together in Cape Town - at the V&A Waterfront. Here, the **Two Oceans Aquarium** showcases the different oceans' wildlife through interactive displays and over 3 000 marine animals. See sharks, penguins, seahorses, jellyfish, turtles and thousands of fish.
