About Berlin

Berlin, Germany's capital, dates to the 13th century. Reminders of the city's turbulent 20th-century history include its Holocaust memorial and the Berlin Wall's Graffitied remains. Divided during the Cold War, its 18th-century Brandenburg Gate has become a symbol of reunification. The city's also known for its art scene and modern landmarks like the gold-colored, swoop-roofed Berliner Philharmonie, built in 1963.

There are several great ways to see Berlin, whether it is by bus, bike, or on foot. One of the easiest ways to see the city and learn a little about the history is on a double decker, open-air Berlin City Hop-on Hop-off Bus Tour. This tour 20 stops at various points of interest, with the option to get off or stay on the bus. For a more in-depth, feet-on-the ground experience, the Berlin Highlights and Hidden Sites Historical Walking Tour offers a four-hour guided walking tour and includes both major attractions and little known sites, from the Brandenburg Gate and Checkpoint.
