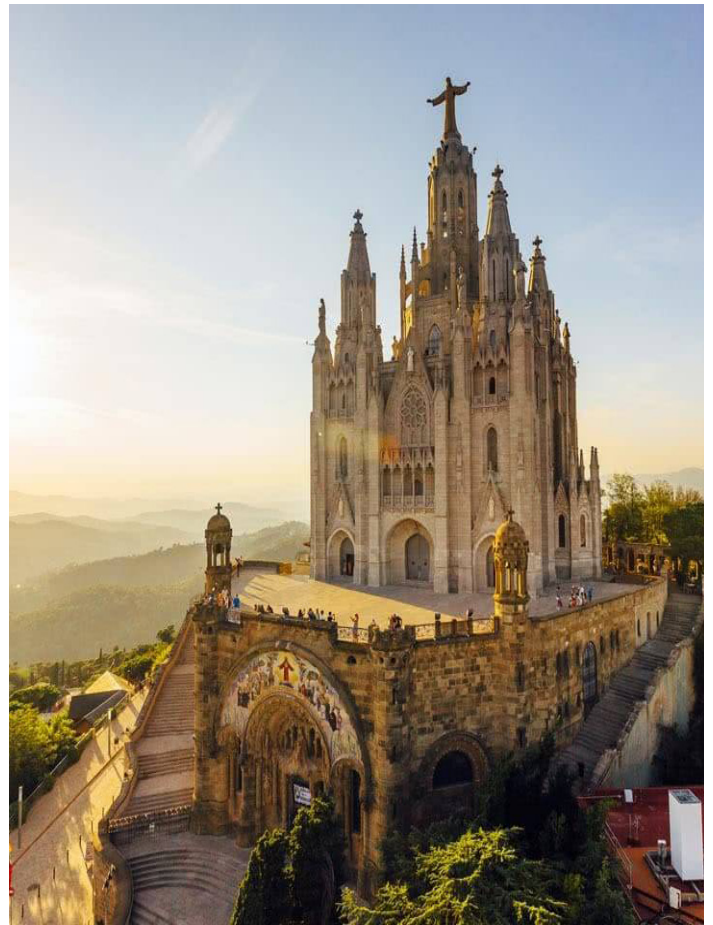
# A dental holiday in SPAIN
