Destination

Sydney, the capital of New South Wales, Australia is known as the Harbor City. It's the largest, city with a population of around 4 million. It has an enviable reputation as one of the world's most beautiful and lies amid a seductive intermingling of land and sea. Sydney is a major global city and one of the most important cities for finance in the Asia-Pacific. Sydney is built around a huge harbor and hosts many tourist attractions as well as a number of beaches, bays and a couple of national parks. Sydney was originally going to be named "Albion", but its founder, Arthur Phillip, changed the name in recognition of Thomas Townshend Lord Sydney's efforts in authorizing the colony's establishment. Sydney annually ranks among worldwide Top Ten Most Liveable Cities lists.
