ABOUT VENUE

Budapest, Hungary's capital, is bisected by the River Danube. Its 19th-century Chain Bridge connects the hilly Buda district with flat Pest. A funicular runs up Castle Hill to Buda's Old Town, where the Budapest History Museum traces city life from Roman times onward. Trinity Square is home to 13th-century Matthias Church and the turrets of the Fishermen's Bastion, which offer sweeping views.

Budapest is the capital and the most populated city of Hungary, and the tenth-largest city in the European Union by population within city limits. The city has an predicted population of 1,752,286 over a land area of about 525 square kilometres (203 square miles). Budapest is both a city and county, and forms the centre of the Budapest metropolitan area, which has an area of 7,626 square kilometres (2,944 square miles) and a population of 3,303,786, constitute 33% of the population of Hungary.

The history of Budapest started when an early Celtic settlement transformed into the Roman town of Aquincum, the capital of Lower Pannonia. The Hungarians appear in the territory in the late 9th century. The area was pillaged by the Mongols in 1241. Buda, the establishment on the west bank of the river, became one of the centres of Renaissance humanist culture by the 15th century. The Battle of Mohács, in 1526, was pursued by nearly 150 years of Ottoman rule. After the reconquest of Buda in 1686, the region entered a new age of welfare. Pest-Buda became a global city with the consolidation of Buda, Óbuda, and Pest on 17 November 1873, with the name 'Budapest' given to the new capital. Budapest also became the co-capital of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, a great power that diffused in 1918, following World War I. The city is the focal point of the Hungarian Revolution of 1848, the Battle of Budapest in 1945, and the Hungarian Revolution of 1956.
