The global market for palliative care is expected to flourish over the forecast period of 2017-2027 due to increasing awareness about the physical, social and psychological, needs of patients with life-threatening diseases and their families. According to WHO, the majority of people receiving hospice care are cancer patients. Increasing incidences of life-threatening illness such as cancer, cardiovascular diseases, Alzheimer disease, kidney failure, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and many more are some of the factors which are responsible during the forecast period of the growth market. Asia-Pacific is giving strong competition in the global Palliative care market by producing a cost-effective treatment that is high in demand in local as well as in the global market. According to the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization (NHPCO), in2014 around 6 to 1.7 million patients received services from palliative care centres. Nearly 60% of palliative care in 2014 was provided at the patient's residence. The palliative care centre industry is in a growth life cycle stage. Over the ten years to 2023, trade price additional, or the industry's contribution to the U.S. economy to grow at an annualized rate of 0.4%. whereas this can be slower than U.S. GDP during the same year (2.2%), this growth is especially driven down by decline within the early a part of the 10-year.




