Pre-IWINETC

- Notification to all registered attendees of all new measures in place / what to expect
- Non-contact registration
- Session booking
- Domestic and WHO advice on travel alongside in-country (Italy) restrictions / conditions, advice and guidance

Precautions during IWINETC

- Larger buses, more frequent and restricted passenger numbers for transfers from Venice and Trieste Airports to Trieste on Monday 26 October
- Face mask and personal sanitizer included in the conference delegate bag
- Contact tracing and thermal-screening
- In-event communications and messaging from the podium which extends to signage including:
 - Reminders on physical distancing measures and behaviours,
 - Reminders about personal hygiene, where to find sanitizer etc,
 - Advice on the availability and wearing and disposal of face masks, gloves etc., Access to medical support

IWINETC will employ a combination of measures to preserve physical distancing which may include:

- Increasing stand footprints and / or decreasing densities
- Extending opening times
- Staggering conference sessions admission and departure times
- Deploying measures including:
 - Introducing barriers
 - Enhanced floor management and stewarding aimed at controlling footfall within the venue itself
 - Spaced seating at conference talks, Encouraging seating only over standing only at exhibitor stands and removing / reducing those areas where attendees could congregate en masse
 - One-way attendee management and physical distancing floor markers
 - Attendees encouraged to make use of readily accessible sanitising stations
 - Contactless payments
 - Imposing firm 'no handshake' or 'cheek kissing' policies .

- Strengthening in-hours and out-of-hours cleaning and disinfection regimes – including ‘deep cleaning’ – paying special attention to high-touch surfaces in line with local and domestic standards
- Larger venues for evening networking activities

Food and wine sampling in line with local guidelines

Ramping-up food hygiene inspections throughout the event period
